### 1. General Statement Of Policy On Health And Safety At Work

- 1.1 JD Excavations are committed to do all that is reasonably practicable to provide a safe and healthy place of work for all employees. - Promote personal responsibility on the part of all employees to avoid and prevent health hazards and injuries to themselves and others who may be affected by their acts or omissions.
